Day 1: March 5

Arrive in Cairo (this will be an overnight flight from the United States so you will depart a day before). A representative will welcome and assist you in getting your VISA before departing for our Cairo hotel. Welcome in the lobby.

CAIRO (No meals)

Day 2: March 6

We will transfer to the Mena House for a buffet breakfast and amazing views of the Pyramids before we go to the **Grand Egyptian Museum** where we will see the famed sold gold King Tutankhamun's death mask and the Royal Mummies room. Later we will visit the Giza Plateau, connecting with the energies of the Giza pyramids and with the whole area. In this field we open our Hearts, Souls and Bodies to the powerful experience we are embarking on. We will have private time inside the **Great Pyramid and the King and Queen's Chamber** (not available to the public) where I will facilitate a group past life regression. You can **ride a camel** (optional)and at night we will return to the pyramids to watch a **sound and light show**.

CAIRO (breakfast)

Day 3: March 7

After breakfast we will return to the Giza Plateau where we will have two hours of private time to stand between the **Paws of the Sphinx** (not available to the public). Afterward, we will go to **Saqqara**, the oldest stone building complex known in history. Later we will fly to Aswan and our hotel.

Day 4: March 8

We will take a short boat ride to the **Temple of Philae**, the center of worship of the Goddess **Isis**. In the afternoon we will travel by boat to visit the **Nubian Village** with its many different colored buildings. The Nubian's were to Egypt as Native American's are to the United States. We will then check in to our cruise ship.

CRUISE SHIP (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

Day 5: March 9

Early morning flight to **Abu Simbel**, discovered in 1813, where temples were carved out of sold rock honoring the Pharoah Ramses II and Queen Nefertari. According to the official theory the two temples of Abu Simbel are the mortuary temples of Ramses II and His Great Queen, Nefertari, but in one guide feels the Nefertari Temple was the mystery school of Hathor, where the priestesses of Hathor were trained. The temple of Ramses was a place of healing, where the priestesses of Hathor lead the wounded men back to the fullness of their Soul. Then enjoy a relaxing afternoon sailing to **Kom Ombo** with an evening visit to the temple dedicated to the two gods Sobek the Crocodile God and Haveris the Sun God.

CRUISE SHIP (Breakfast, lunch and dinner)

Day 6: March 10

In the morning we will journey to **Edfu** by horse and carriage. Edu is the largest temple dedicated to Horus and Hathor before we continue sailing towards Luxor and explore our past lives in a regression. In the afternoon, we'll tour the East Bank of Luxor and in the early evening and visit **Luxor Temple.**

CRUISE SHIP (breakfast, lunch and dinner)

Day 7: March 11

We'll start our day early to explore a number of tombs in the **Valley of the Kings** and in the **Valley of the Queens** we will see the **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut** and visit the **Nefartari** tomb. We'll also visit the **Colossi of Memnon** and the **Temple of Karnack.** Some say Karnak was the spot where creation began.

Day 8: March 12

We will explore the **Dendara** site, dedicated to Hathor, and then we'll go to **Abydos.** A site honoring Osiris, Isis, Horus, Seti 1 and more.

Day 9: March 13

We will fly from Luxor to Cairo and see the Islamic areas of Cairo including the **Citadel of Saladdin**. Then on to the **Coptic area** where the Romans constructed the fortress of Babylon built over the ruins of two towers of St Mary, followed by **St. Sergious** said to be the resting place of the Holy Family when they traveled to Egypt. Later, we will have a walking tour around El Moaz and the **Khan El Khalili Bizarre.**
