

Sacred England Journey

This is an OPTIONAL post-journey from Scotland

We'll fly from Edinburgh to Bristol, England and then drive to the charming town of Bath. Beneath its city streets lays an extensive set of hot springs that the Romans once believed could cure their ailments (you can visit the Roman Baths during your free time). Our journey will include Glastonbury, known as the Isle of Avalon, and we'll visit the magical Avebury, West Kennet Long Barrel, and end with a stunning private sunset INSIDE the ancient stones of Stonehenge.

We'll drive through the lands of legends where dragons fly and crystals emerge from the ground, where you'll meet real earth energy workers, witches and saints and drive on the Michael ley line into the wilds of Dartmoor. Here we cross bridges over 4,000 years old and wander in the magical Wistman's Faerie Wood. It is said Merlin himself worked and initiated druids in Tintagel. We will bravely clamber into 'Merlin's Cave' where we will do a visualization and then walk into the beautiful St Nectan's Glen and its waterfall. Here a space is held for the Fairies and the spirit of the 5th century Celtic Christian Saint Nectan. This is said to be the place where the Knights of the Round Table came to be blessed before their quest for the Holy Grail.

ENGLAND:

- **Glastonbury Abbey:** Joseph of Arimathea as well as King Arthur may be buried here. This mystical land will capture your heart.
- **Glastonbury Tor:** Shrouded in mystery and intrigue, it is rich in legends. It is a major center for energy and ley lines and some say fairies live here. It is the sacred hill of Avalon.
- **Chalice Well:** The best known and most loved holy well in England believed to possess healing properties. Some say it is where the Holy Grail was hidden centuries ago.
- **Avebury:** This beautiful quaint town contains the largest megalithic stone circle in the world where we can easily touch the stones and have time to meditate.
- West Kennet Long Barrel: A Neolithic tomb or barrow built around 3,650 BC.
- **Stonehenge (INSIDE the stones at Sunset)** *Awaiting permission*: Quite simply one of the most magnificent wonders of the world erected 5,000 years ago.
- Bath Abbey: In 973 the King of England, King Edgar, was crowned here.
- King Arthur's Cromwell and Merlin's cave: An adventure into the wilds of SW England.

WHAT'S INCLUDED: Transportation to Edinburgh airport from our hotel (as a group), airfare to Bristol (on our designated flight), 5 night's accommodations, daily breakfast, entrance fees for stated sites, ground transportation (as a group), tours and guides.

WHATS <u>NOT</u> **INCLUDED:** International or domestic airfare not mentioned, meals not specified, all beverages, passports, independent transportation other than what is included in the itinerary (as a group), all personal items, insurance (travel insurance is *highly* recommended to cover unforeseen circumstance that could lead you to canceling your place on the tour), gratuities (bus driver, bellmen, guides, hotel staff), personal expenses or single room options. Our awe-inspiring journey ends in Bath.

From Bath you can choose to fly back to Edinburgh, or take a train to London to fly home or elsewhere.
