Journey with me to some of the most powerful and sacred sites in **SCOTLAND**. Scottish folklore is rich with fairy legends. Experience the myth, magic, and mystery of the land as it blends into a beautiful tapestry of soul deepening and wonderment. You will experience some of the most breathtaking land that will forever touch your heart and soul. Join me on a spiritual journey through the mists of time.

## **SCOTLAND:**

- Edinburgh: We'll begin in Old Town and explore Greyfriars Kirkyard (for Harry Potter fans), the gates of Edinburgh castle, the Witches Well, walk down Royal Mile St. Giles' Cathedral and I'll facilitate our first group past life regression.
- **Rosslyn Chapel:** As seen in DaVinci Code, this spectacular and uniquely beautiful chapel is connected to the Templars. We will be guided around the glen learning its history. At night we will have private time into the Rosslyn Chapel for our group only (*if available*).
- **Inverary Castle:** Seat of the Dukes of Argyll, chiefs of Clan Campbell since the 18th century.
- **Dervaig Church:** See a beautiful stained glass of Mary Magdalene with Jesus.
- **Iona:** Once an important Druid/Celtic site, it's considered the most sacred place in Scotland.
- Staffa and Fingals Cave: Basalt columns thought to once connect to the Ireland.
- **Fairy Pools:** Beautiful rock pools of crystal clear water fed by a series of waterfalls. We will walk to the various pools and take in the natural beauty of the land.
- **Quiraing:** The Isle of Skye is absolutely intoxicating with its beautiful unique emerald green mountains located along the coast.
- **The Storr:** Legend states that the "old man of Storr" was a giant and is a beacon for spiritual travelers on the Isle of Skye.
- **Fairy Glen:** The fairies were believed to live deep within the heather. The belief in fairies, goes back to prehistoric times. The landscape is captivating!
- **Colloden Battlefield:** The Jacobite rebellion was the final battle to be held on British soil and defeated the Jacobite Rising on April 16, 1746, thus cementing Britain as a Protestant nation.
- Standing Stones: Standing Stones are locations where mystical energy congregates. We'll see:
  - **Dervaig Standing Stones:** Prehistoric megalithic standing stones

- Callanish Stones: considered the 'Stonehenge of the North.' Built around 3000 BC the stones actually predate Stonehenge by approximately 2,000 years and are laid out in a circle and a cross. The tallest stone is 22 feet high.
- **Clach an Trushal:** Meaning "Stone of Compassion." It is the tallest standing stone in Scotland and the only remaining stone that was once part of a circle of stones built 5,000 years ago.
- **Clava Cairns c**omposed of a well-preserved group of burial cairns and standing stones that date to about 4,000 years ago.

**Group Past Life Regressions:** During our journey I will facilitate several group past life regressions offering opportunities for healing your heart, mind and soul. Learning who you were gives you a deeper understanding of your soul's journey and can clear blocks within you from a time long ago.

**WHAT'S INCLUDED:** 11 night's accommodations, daily breakfast, 8 dinners, entrance fee for stated sites, ground transportation (as a group at a specified time), and group past life regressions.

**WHATS** <u>NOT</u> **INCLUDED:** International airfare or airfare within Europe, meals not specified, all beverages, passports, independent transportation other than what is included in the itinerary (as a group), all personal items, gratuities (guides, bus driver, bellman, hotel and restaurant staff), personal expenses, single room option and insurance.
