## Day 1: Sa March 6

Arrival

Steinberger Hotel, Cairo (B)

Once you've arrived to **Cairo**, you'll be greeted by a representative upon departing your plane. The representative will assist you with getting your VISA, going through customs, retrieving your luggage and driving you to our hotel. Our wonderful Egyptologist, Sayed, will be with us each step of the way guiding us and sharing his vast knowledge. (See next page for the optional early arrival PRE-TOUR).

## Day 2: Su March 7

Welcome | GEM Museum

Steinberger Hotel (B,L)

After breakfast we'll have a **Welcome Ceremony**, review our journey, and discuss hypnosis and past life regression. In the afternoon, we'll visit the completed and magnificent **Great Egyptian Museum** (GEM) where you can see the famed solid gold King Tutankhamun's death mask. Sound and light show at the Pyramids at night (if available/optional).

## Day 3: M March 8 Group Regression in Great Pyramid | Camel Ride Steinberger Hotel (B,L)

We'll have private time very *early morning* inside the king's chamber of the **Great Pyramid** where I will facilitate a group past life regression. Then we'll visit the **Queen's Chamber** (if open) before enjoying a delicious buffet breakfast at the beautiful Mena house with amazing views of the Pyramids. Afterwards, we'll return to the pyramids for photos and **ride a camel** (optional) through the Sahara Desert at Giza. Lunch overlooking the pyramids and visit a top jewelry store.

## Day 4: T March 9

Sphinx | Saqqara | Fly to Aswan

Movenpick Hotel, Aswan (B)

We'll head back to the Giza Plateau in the early morning to have private time between the **paws of the Great Sphinx of Giza**. Tourists are not allowed between the paws, so this is a VERY unique experience. We will then visit **Saqqara**, home of the Step Pyramid of Djoser, the oldest pyramid. We'll then fly to Aswan and check into our hotel.

## Day 5: W March 10

Nubian Village

Movenpick Hotel, Aswan (B)

You'll enjoy a relaxing morning at our beautiful hotel. Felucca ride on the Nile is available (optional). In the afternoon we will visit a Nubian Village. The Nubians are an indigenous people from ancient Africa.

## Day 6: R March 11

Sahara Desert | Abu Simbel Nubian Village, Abu Simbel (B)

We'll depart in the morning by bus to experience the Sahara Desert as we drive to Abu Simbel. In the afternoon, we'll visit the Abu Simbel temples. The site has long been sacred grounds to the goddess Hathor.

Next to Ramses II temple is the temple of his beloved Nefertari, once thought to be a place of training for priestesses.

**Day 7: F March 12      Abu Simbel | Temple of Isis | Cruise      5-Star Nile Cruise (B,L,D)**

We'll take to a flight to Aswan and a short boat ride to the Temple of Philae. Once the center of worship of the Goddess Isis, it has attracted pilgrims from all over the ancient world. Here you will experience an anointing ceremony to open your third eye. We will then transfer to our cruise ship and check in.

**Day 8: Sa March 13      Kom Ombo | Edfu Temples      5-Star Nile Cruise (B,L,D)**

We'll visit the temple of Kom Ombo dedicated to the two gods: Sobek the crocodile God and Horus the Sun God. Then we'll spend a beautiful relaxing day sailing on the Nile before we arrive at Edfu Temple and visit by horse and carriage.

**Day 9: Su March 14      Karnack | Luxor Temples      5-Star Nile Cruise (B,L,D)**

Early morning rise for a hot air balloon ride (optional). We'll then visit the Temple of Karnack, the main center of worship and the religious heart of Egypt. As an added bonus, we will have private time with the powerful statue of the lioness-headed goddess Sekmet inside a small, often locked Temple of Ptah. It is considered a place of intense energy. At night we'll explore Luxor Temple. Here you will see the Avenue of Sphinxes, a 2-mile path connecting Luxor Temple to Karnak temple lined with sphinxes.

**Day 10: M March 15      Valley of Kings and Queens (Hatshepsut)      Sonesta Luxor Hotel (B)**

Sayed will take us on a tour to explore a number of Tombs in the Valley of the Kings, including the tomb of Tutankhamun and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut in the Valley of the Queens. We will visit Nefertari's tomb *if open*. (optional). We'll then check into our beautiful hotel on the Nile.

**Day 11: T March 16      Abydos | Dendera      Sonesta Luxor Hotel (B)**

We'll drive north, past Naga Hammadi (where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered) to temple of Abydos, one of Egypt's oldest and most sacred cities where we'll explore this magnificent site honoring Osiris, Isis, Horus, and Seti 1. We'll then drive to the Temple of Dendera, dedicated to Hathor and a center for the worship of Isis and Osiris.

**Day 12 W March 17      Group Regression | Closing      Le Meridien Cairo Airport Hotel (B)**

We'll have a Group Past Life Regression and Closing before we fly from Luxor to Cairo airport and check into our hotel.

**Day 13 R March 18      Departures**

**\*OPTIONAL PRE-TOUR      March 5 arrival      Le Riad De Charme Boutique Hotel**

Early arrival is *optional* but strongly encouraged due to the time change and very long flights. Arrivals to Cairo are typically in the late afternoon or evening as it is an overnight flight from the United States. It is *highly recommended*, but it is *optional*. There is an additional room cost.

Once you've arrived in Cairo, you'll be greeted by a representative upon departing your plane. The representative will assist you with getting your VISA, going through customs, getting your luggage, and transporting you to Le Raid de Charme, a charming boutique hotel located in a very old part of Cairo in the Kaham El Khalili area. Dinner is on your own due to varying arrivals, but the hotel's rooftop restaurant is delicious. This part of Cairo is ANCIENT (our street is nearly 1,000 years old) and WONDERFUL!

The next morning is free to give you a chance to acclimate to the time change and catch your breath. Relax in the morning before our wonderful Egyptologist/Guide, Sayed, shows us around this ancient city. We'll then be transported to the Steinberger Hotel.
