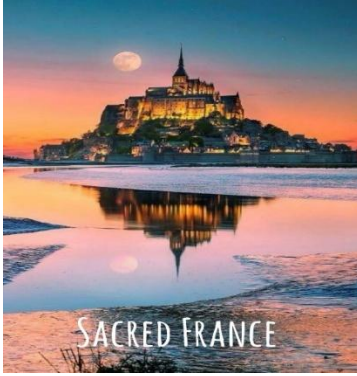




Sacred France Journey

Join me on one of the most empowering, inspiring and sacred journeys exploring the mysteries of France!

Our spiritual journey will allow you to experience what your soul needs: a personal awakening, a soul deepening or a soul healing in the sacred sites we visit, including:

- **Paris:** Our journey begins with a welcome ceremony in a beautiful park overlooking Notre Dame. Our walking tour will include Point Zero and Notre Dame, Saint Julien le Pauvre, Saint Severin, and Saint Sulpice churches. Welcome dinner.
- **Chartres Cathedral:** In the beautiful town of Chartres lies the magnificent Chartres Cathedral. We will explore the church (and its mysteries with our knowledgeable guide) and walk it's sacred 42-foot labyrinth. In the crypt below we'll see a Black Madonna, Druid Healing Well, and a piece of Mother Mary's veil.
- **Mont Saint Michel:** We'll travel to Mont St. Michel by train enjoying the picturesque French countryside. Explore MSM and have it to ourselves in the evening as we spend the night there.
- **Limoux:** After traveling by train to Limoux, we'll visit Notre Dame de Marseille with its Black Madonna and Healing Well. We'll then explore Eglise Notre-Dame de Vals, a beautiful medieval church, carved inside a giant rock formation.
- **Montsegur:** The last stronghold of the Cathars and where we we'll walk to the top (if you choose) and explore the village.
- **Rennes-le-Chateau:** The inspiration for books such as *Holy Blood, Holy Grail* and *The Da Vinci Code*. This is where the 19th-century priest, Berenger Sauniere, discovered secret documents! We'll visit the Church of Saint Mary Magdalene, Tour Magdala, the museum for Sauniere, experience a beautiful meditation followed by Magdalene inspired music by David Bailey in a Visigoth castle.
- **Nebias:** A beautiful enchanting forest with fairy energy we'll explore.
- **Fountain of Love:** Where legend says Magdalene did baptisms.
- **Alet-les-Bains:** Known as "The Chosen Place," where we'll visit the home where Nostradamus lived with his grandparents and experience a past life regression here (if available). We'll walk through the medieval town and explore the beautiful ruins of the 9th century Benedictine monastery and Abbey before experiencing the unique energy at nearby 12th-century St. Salvyre.
- **Carcassonne:** Here we will BC, walk the cobblestone streets and explore the ancient medieval walled city (and UNESCO site) first settled in 3,500 and see the Basilique Saint Nazaire.
- **Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer:** Our journey will take us to where Mary Magdalene arrived on the Mediterranean seashore. We'll visit the 9th century church, Notre Dame de la Mer, and a famous Black Madonna known as Sara-la-Kali (Sara the Black).
- **Abbey of St. Victor:** Legends say it holds the remains of Lazarus and a 3rd century Black Madonna.
- **Notre-dame de la Garde:** Located on the highest point in Marseille it is breathtaking both inside and out and is known to locals as la Bonne Mere (the Good Mother).

I will facilitate several Group Past Life Regressions during our journey including Mont Saint-Michel and inside the home of Nostradamus (if available).

**As a special treat*, Michelle Campbell will guide us at Chartres sharing the history of the labyrinth, sacred geometry, and its symbolism. At Rennes les Chateaux we'll enjoy a beautiful meditation in the backyard of a friend's home overlooking Ruisseau des Couleurs (River of Colors) valley.

WHAT'S INCLUDED: Accommodation: 13 nights (September 9-22), breakfast daily, 7 dinners, expert local guides, trains (Paris to Chartres R/T, Paris to Mont Saint Michel R/T, Paris to Toulouse, Carcassonne to Arles). Ground transportation (as a group at a specified time), entrance fees/tours.

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED: International airfare or airfare within Europe (our journey ends in Marseille), meals not specified, all beverages, passports, transportation not included in the itinerary, travel insurance, personal expenses, tipping (hotel staff, bus driver, tour guides) or single room options.

Double occupancy is on a first-come basis. Early bird rate a savings of \$400. **After March 1**, the price is **\$6,399**. Full payment is due by June 1, 2027. If I don't have a roommate for you, you will pay the additional single occupancy rate. Single supplement: **\$1,495** additional (13 nights).

*Payment made by Zelle, Venmo or Check. (*Once payment is made, it is non-refundable and non-transferable.*) Travel insurance is **HIGHLY** recommended and **strongly suggested** to protect your investment. Allianz and Travel Guard are two well-respected companies. Your **deposit of \$200** secures your place on the tour and is *non-refundable (deducted from the total amount)*. A surcharge of will be added if the US/Euro varies over 5%.)

Limited group size of 14 people for an exclusive and more personal journey.

PARIS PRE-TOUR (OPTIONAL): Come a day early to enjoy Paris and get acclimated to the time change. I'll keep you busy and awake. Let's have some fun! Arrive to our hotel by 11 am (most flights arrive very early). We'll visit Sacre Coeur and view Paris from its highest point, explore Montmartre, be awed by the stunningly beautiful Paris Opera House, visit La Madeline (Magdalene) church, enjoy a beautiful cruise on the Seine River viewing the famous sites and visit the 2nd level of the Eiffel Tower for a spectacular view of Paris. **WHAT'S INCLUDED:** Your room in Paris (September 8), ground transportation and admission to all of the above-mentioned sites: **\$299 pp** based on double occupancy. Private room is **\$175** additional.



Here are some of the fabulous accommodations we will stay at including: near the banks of the Seine in Paris, on Mont St. Michel, inside the medieval walls of Carcassonne, on the Mediterranean beach where Magdalene first arrived, on the Old Port of Marseille, and in our own Chateau in the mystical land known as the Languedoc. Rich in the history of Mary Magdalene, Cathars, and Knights Templars, it's a region known to awaken oneself and has been considered sacred ground for thousands of years.
