Join me on a beautiful journey through Italy exploring sacred sites....and bonus- eating lots of pasta and gelato.

- **ROME:** We'll explore the Colosseum, Palatine Hill, and Forum. The Basilica of San Clemente includes the lower level with ruins of a pagan temple dating to earlier than the 1st century. Above is a level that is in the 4th century and above that the 12th century. At the Basilica de San Giovanni de Florentine we'll see remnants of what is thought to be Magdalene's left foot. The first foot was the first to enter the empty cave where Jesus was laid. We'll also see the Piazza Navona, the Pantheon and Chiesa di Santa Maria (Church of Mary Magdalene), the Vatican, Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica. And of course, the Trevi fountain, only a two-minute walk from our hotel.
- **TUSCANY AND MONTEPULCIANO:** We'll travel to a beautiful wine vineyard in Tuscany and enjoy a 3-course lunch along with wine tasting before exploring the medieval hilltop town of Montepulciano with sweeping vineyard views and Renaissance architecture.
- **POMPEII AND POSITANO:** Our expert guide will show us this ancient Roman city remarkably preserved by the catastrophic eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD and the Temple of Isis. We'll enjoy the drive along the Amalfi coastline to Positano where we'll explore the picturesque cliffside village for several hours.
- **FLORENCE:** We'll see the Cattedrale di Santa Maria de Fiore, also known as the Duomo. At the Galleria dell' Accademia world-renowned art museum famous for housing Michelangelo's iconic statue of David, the Ponte Vecchio ("Old Bridge"), and a leather market. Plus, a free day to explore the beautiful streets of Florence, visit other museums, get a massage or perhaps go on a tour to Cinque Terre and Pisa (optional).
- **VERONA:** Famous as the setting for Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet. Our hotel will look at Juliet's Balcony where we'll have exclusive use in the evening. We'll also visit Juliet's Museum, a popular square for outdoor shopping and Verona Arena, where the closing ceremony of the Olympics was held.
- **VENICE:** St. Mark's Square, Cafe Florian, Doges Palace, Harry's Bar, St. Mark's Basilica, Rialto ridge, La Maddalena, cruise down the Grand River in a Vaporetto, Burano, Murano and go on a gondola ride (optional).

WHAT'S INCLUDED: Accommodation: 11 nights 4-star hotels and a 3.5 star hotel that overlooks Juliet's Balcony and courtyard. Breakfast daily, 2 lunches, expert local guides, trains (Rome to Florence, Florence to Verona, Verona to Venice), ground transportation (as a group at a specified time), over 25 sites, tours and entrance fees. I will facilitate several group past life regressions.

WHATS NOT INCLUDED: International airfare or airfare within Europe (our journey ends in Venice), meals not specified, all beverages, passports, transportation not included in the itinerary, travel insurance, personal expenses, tipping (hotel staff, tour guides), single room options and anything not mentioned in WHAT'S INCLUDED above.
